



Application Guidelines for Academic Scholarship Awards **Durand Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee**

Several Academic Scholarship Awards of \$500 will be awarded each May to support students for the next academic year, e.g. 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, etc. Academic Scholarship are awarded without regard to race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, age, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status to applicants who are currently enrolled in or have been accepted into a post-secondary course of study in an accredited educational program in the United States. Priority will be given to applicants who have not received an Academic Scholarship Award from the Durand Heritage Foundation. Family membership in the Durand Heritage Foundation is not required to be eligible for an Academic Scholarship Award.

1. Applicants must submit a *complete* Application for Academic Scholarship Award (see application form and requirements on pages 2 and 3)
2. Applications must be submitted between February 1 and March 31. Mailed applications must be post-marked no later than March 31. If submitted electronically, applications must be time-stamped before 11:59 p.m. March 31.
3. Academic Scholarship Awards will be announced in May
4. Scholarship funds awarded will be sent to successful applicants by July
5. At the end of the academic year, Academic Scholarship Award recipients must provide to the Durand Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee a brief report on their educational experience for the academic year.
